4. Effective Date, Duration and Termination of the MoU:

8. Confidentiality:
This MoU shall be private and confidential and the Parties hereto shall not disclose or divulge the contents hereof to any third party.

Neither party shall disclose any information or share any data concerning the affairs of other party which may have come to its knowledge by virtue of this association or

9. Non-Exclusivity Clause: This agreement is in no way exclusive and the signing parties remain free to make

similar agreements with other institutions of their choice and also to execute any obligations arising from already concluded agreements.

10. Force Majeure:

Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to Acts of God, war, flood, earthquake, strike, lockouts, epidemics,

pandemic, riots, civil commotion etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any

such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions

continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future

11. Enforceability:

The aforementioned protocol and co-operation can only be implemented in a legally binding form on the basis of special agreements and other adopted resolutions, which may be elaborated in future and then also subject to the national laws of the country. It is made clear that nothing hereinabove, whether express or by necessary implication,

shall be enforceable as against either party, and no right or liability, as the case may be, shall arise from this Agreement in favour and/or as against any of the parties hereto.

12. Settlement of Disputes:

Any dispute, conflict of interest or problems arising from the application or interpretation of this MoU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and in good faith.
